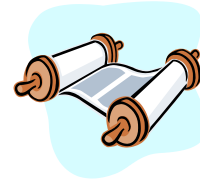
Another Graduate

July 16-August 15 the exhibition of the only Dead Sea Scroll Biblical fragments in American and other Ancient Biblical Manuscripts and rare Bibles collected from around the world may be seen at **Adam's Mark Hotel in Indianapolis, Indiana** (Soon to be the Hilton-Indianapolis). It is located at 120 W. Market St., Indianapolis, IN Exhibit highlights include:

- Biblical Dead Sea Scroll fragments from the Old Testament, the very earliest Biblical fragments in existence.
- Exodus fragments in Greek from the 4th Century
- A 3rd Century excerpt from Paul's letter to the Colossians
- Many important 16th Century Bibles in English
- A First Edition of the King James Bible from 1611
- The First Bible in English ever printed in America
- The First Catholic Bible printed in America
- The earliest writing
