Carol's Comments

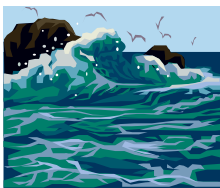
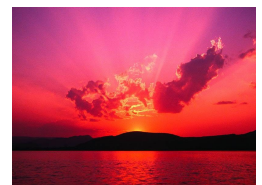
"Have You Seen Jesus Today?"
