Bethany Theological Seminary Announces 2004 Founders Lectures

Dr. Walter Brueggemann is Professor Emeritus of Old Testament at Columbia Theological Seminary, Decatur, Georgia and an ordained minister in the United Church of Christ. He is the author of numerous articles and books, including the most recently published *Inscribing the Text: Sermons and Prayers of Walter Brueggemann* (2004), *An Introduction to the Old Testament: The Canon and Christian Imagination* (2003), and *Reverberations of Faith* (2002). He has served on the Editorial Council of the Journal of Biblical Literature and has honors and awards, including Rockefeller Doctoral Fellow, and the Book of the Year awards from the Academy of Parish Clergy and the Catholic Press Association for Theology of the Old Testament. Dr. Brueggemann has conducted dozens of lectures at colleges and seminaries in the United States and abroad. The speaking schedule is as follows:
